A dry wine with delicate apple and zingy citrus fruit flavours, with a crisp refreshing finish.

Hidden Road, Chardonnay (Australia)

A medium dry white wine with well rounded flavours of peach and lemongrass with a zesty finish.

J Brader Liebfraumilch (Germany)

Made using a blend of the rivaner, riesling and scheurebe grape, it is a medium style.

Los Romeros, Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)

A dry fruity white wine with aromas of herbs, grass and zippy lemon and citrus flavours

Los Romeros, Merlot Rosé (Chile)

A soft, easy drinking wine with strawberry, raspberry and red plum fruit flavours.

Los Romeros, Merlot (Chile)

A smooth red wine, full of character with flavours of plums, cherries and spice.

Hidden Road, Shiraz (Spain)

A rich red wine bursting with ripe berries and brambles and a hint of spice.

|    | Classically a third of each pinot noir, pinot mernier and chardonnay, providing delightfully dry crisp champagne. |        |
| 3. | <b>Mercier Brut Rosé</b>  | £42.00 |
|    | A fresh, fruity full bodied champagne with a soft rounded finish.   |        |
| 4. | <b>Asti Spumate, Sant Orsola (Italy)</b>  | £18.50 |
|    | This well loved sparkling wine is highly aromatic with the classic bouquet of the moscato grape.                  |        |
| 5. | <b>Prosecco (Italy)</b>   | £18.00 |
|    | A light and refreshing sparkling wine, with gentle fizz, apple and pear notes and a soft finish.                  |        |

|     | A classic Sancerre, full of crisp ripe acidity and gooseberry fruit flavours.                             |        |
| 8.  | Villa Maria Gewürztraminer (New Zealand)  | £28.00 |
|     | Rich and spicy with exotic fruit flavours.  |        |
| 9.  | Footsteps Pinot Grigio, Veneto (Italy)  | £14.00 |
|     | A light fruity unoaked wine with plenty of green apple fruit flavours.                                    |        |
| 10. | Piesporter Michelsberg (Mosel)  | £14.00 |
|     | A refreshing medium sweet wine with an aroma of ripe nectarines.  |        |
| 11. | Footsteps Chardonnay (Australia)  | £13.90 |
|     | This is a fresh citrusy wine with good texture and a subtle hint of oak on the finish.                    |        |
| 12. | Footsteps Rosé (California)   | £13.90 |
|     | Made predominantly from the zinfandel grape, it is lively, fruity and exploding with red berry flavours.  |        |

## Red Wine

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| 13. | Fleurie, Ch. de Fleurie (Beaujolais)   | £31.00 |
|     | Luscious fruity red wine made from the gamay grape possessing easy drinking charm.                                   |        |
| 14. | Marques de Morano, Rioja Tinto (Spain)   | £21.00 |
|     | A lighter style of the fruity rioja with just a hint of a traditional oakiness.                                      |        |
| 15. | Kleine Zalze Gamay/Noir (South Africa)   | £19.00 |
|     | A blend of pinot noir and gamay grapes that produces a soft, fruity easy drinking wine.                              |        |
| 16. | Trivento Malbec Reserve (Argentina)  | £18.00 |
|     | A medium bodied wine with textured tannins, plum and raspberry flavours and a hint of vanilla.                       |        |
| 17. | Concha Y Toro, Cassillero Del Diablo Cabernet Sauvignon  | £17.00 |
|     | A full bodied cabernet sauvignon with flavours of blackcurrant and cherries with hints of coffee and dark chocolate. |        |
| 18. | Mill Cellars Shiraz (SE Australia)   | £16.00 |
|     | A well structured wine with brambly fruit on the palate and a hint of spice.   |        |
| 19. | Footsteps Merlot (Languedoc)   | £13.90 |
|     | Juicy, richly flavoured with supple tannins and lively aromas of redcurrant and black cherry.                        |        |
| 20. | Footsteps Shiraz (Australia)   | £13.90 |
|     | Rich, vibrant red berry fruit bursting with spicy blackberry aromas and a dash of toasty oak.                        |        |
